**Overall Objective:**

The project is aiming to develop, enhance and evaluate impact assessment and management tools for the sustainable land use of the watershed areas of coastal deltas.

**Specific Objectives:**

1. To create an integrated database system involving all relevant European research and application practices;
2. To foster communication and collaboration on land management, in target deltas;
3. To develop land-use models for target deltas;
4. To induce a cooperative institutional structure;
5. To create cooperation and networking among scientists, land developers and decision makers in Black Sea Basin;
6. To develop an environmental education program.

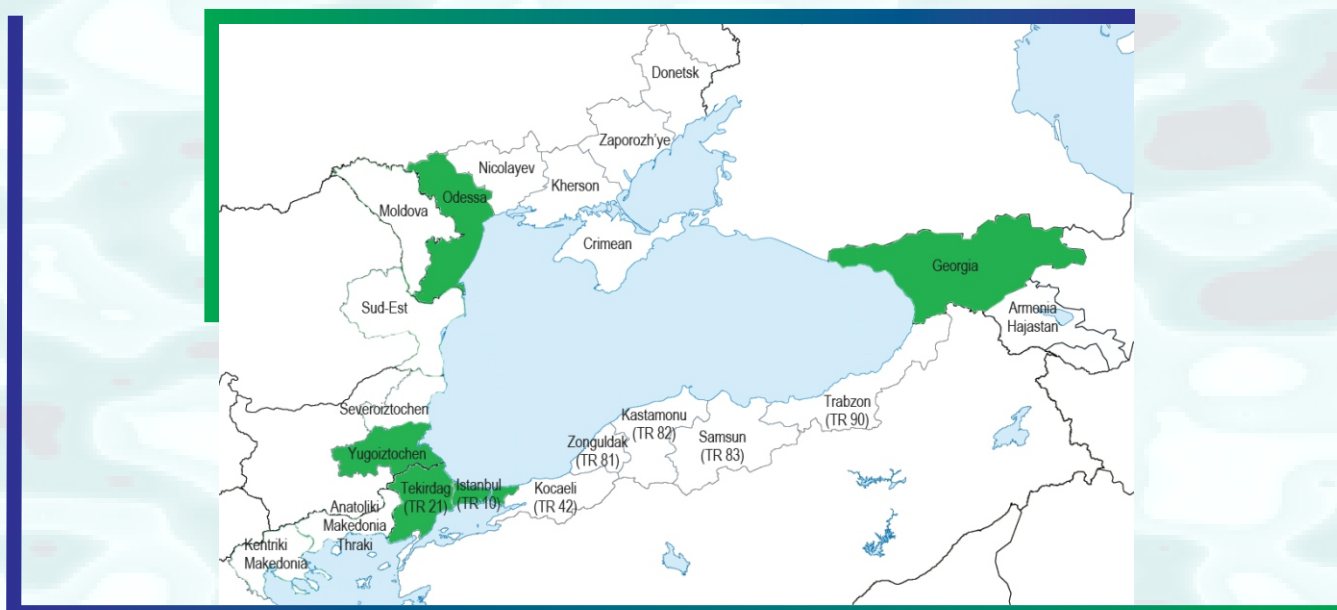
