Overall Objective:

The project is aiming to mobilize local resources for creation of a common cultural environment for the Black Sea Basin communities.

Specific Objectives:

- 1. To foster integration and sharing of cultural heritage and traditions of within the Black Sea region.
- 2. To upgrade skills and knowledge and build capacity and competencies of managers in the culture field in the Black Sea region.
- 3. To support children and youth from Black Sea communities to get involved in cultural and art related activities.
- 4. To stimulate the mutual understanding between communities and the respect for cultural diversity within the Black Sea Basin.
- 5. To create a sustainable network for long term cooperation in the field of culture and art.

Expected results:

- O Established sustainable cross-border network for culture and art, open to NGOs, institutions, informal formations and individual artists in the field of culture within the Black Sea region.
- Enhanced integration of the population within the Black Sea region, based on the shared cultural heritage and traditions.
- 2 80 cultural managers would have upgraded their skills and knowledge and would have built capacity and competencies.
- O Developed a multicultural model for a sustainable cooperation in the cultural filed within the Black Sea region, in accordance with the principles of the European Union.
- 200 children and youngsters would have been interested in the culture and art of the Black Sea region.
- O Increased interest towards the partner towns as tourist destinations as a result of the new cultural events and created network for cultural exchange.

- Establishment of a Regional Network for Cooperation in the Culture sphere "Black Sea Areal for Culture and Art" (cultural centre, website of the network, etc.).
- O Cultural Events in the Black Sea Areal for Culture and Art (International Folklore Fair of the Traditions of Black Sea Communities in Odessa, Ukraine; Musical Happening "Water Songs" in the town of Chorlu, Turkey; International Creative Art Workshop "Black Sea Palette" in Burgas, Bulgaria; International Theatre Festival "Myths and Legends of the Black Sea Communities" in Komotini, Greece; Culinary Exhibition with Workshop, town of Chorlu, Turkey; Creative Workshop for Children "Wonders from the Sea" in Burgas, Bulgaria).


