**Overall Objective:**

The project is aiming to promote exchange of educational values and experiences between universities in partner countries, through a joint educational program and network.

**Specific Objectives:**

1. To identify common components of educational programs between universities in partner countries;
2. To promote educational values using online and offline instruments;
3. To strengthen regional identity by creating a virtual community between universities.

**Main Activities:**

- Carrying out exchanges of good practices (common workshops) for identifying the components of common educational programs to be developed in the project;
- Development and implementing of facultative/free of charge course modules on educational topics per each university: "Capitalizing on the regional identities in the educational development and identifying the educational paths in the Black Sea area";
- Development and implementing of the modules in digital format (eLearning platform) for the partner universities;
- Carrying out regional partnerships (between educational environments from the same countries) in order to implement the new modules - free access to modules "based" on partnership;
- Developing two student exchange programs in Turkey Universities for students with outstanding results obtained by participating in the implemented modules;
- Creation of a social network /exchange of experience between the students participating in the modules developed in the 4 countries (individual profile + common channels) - Black Sea Social network;
- Development of a portal as a news network of the universities and disseminating within the portal the information related to the project.

**Expected results:**

- Components of common educational programs to be developed identified;
- The brochure "White Paper of best practices in joint educational programs" issued;
- A joint educational program to promote the educational values created;
- Two student exchange programs for 12 students with outstanding results implemented;
- At least 5 partnerships with educational institutions signed;
- A social network for students and universities fully functional;
- A portal for disseminating information fully functional.

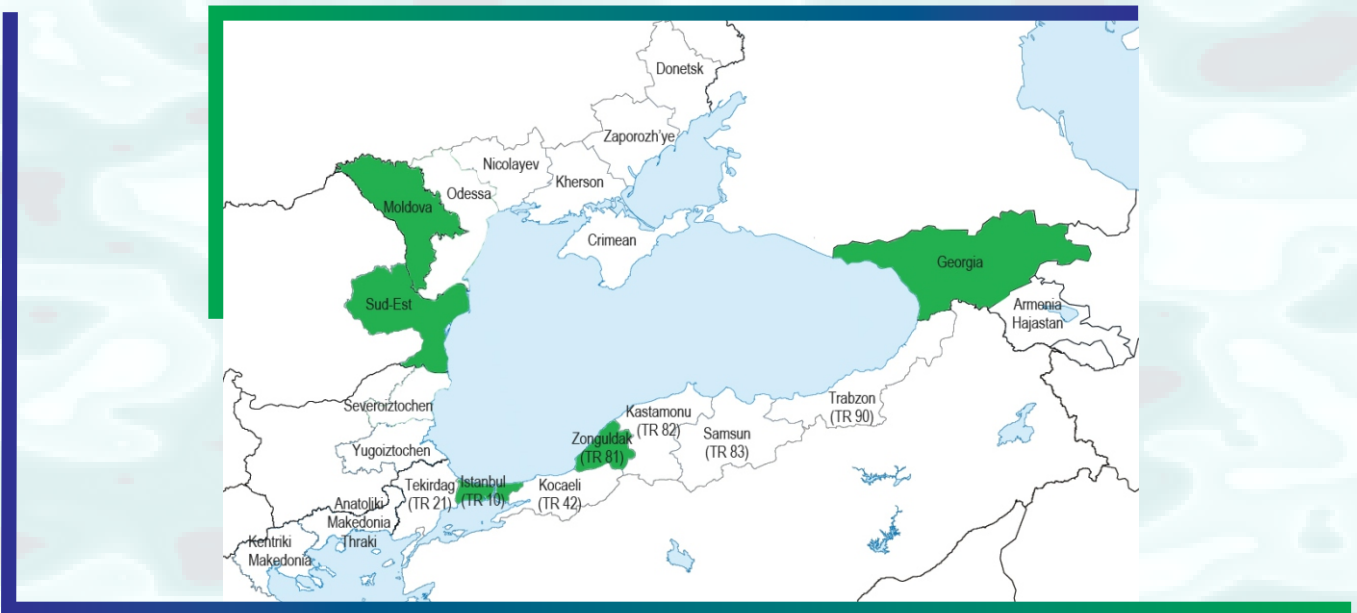
