Overall Objective:

The project is aiming to share competencies and innovative tools for the protection of protected areas by fires.

Specific Objectives:

- 1. To promote research and innovation in the filed of fire suppression to protect protected natural areas.
- 2. To utilize new technologies by developing a holistic and complete fire suppression system.
- 3. To allow the identification of the areas of greatest danger of having fires
- 4. To utilize a sustainable way stream of water to suppress fires in protected areas that will be land vehicles during the night and planes and helicopters during the day.
- 5. To develop a software for the optional location of the water reservoirs and mobilization of fire vehicles.
- 6. To operate a neighbour network of experts in fire suppression.



Main Activities:

- O Building up a neighbourhood network.
- O Developing a Digital Geographic Database.
- O Developing a forest fire potential danger and behaviour software.
- O Modifying and validating the Runoff Model for the research areas.
- O Identifying the number, the dimensions and the optimal locations of the reservoirs for fire suppression.
- O Optimizing the mobilization of the land fire vehicles.

Enhanced protection of the protected area due to the suppression of the danger of fires.


