***Objectives***

- To provide information, training, and tips on the main steps in preparing transnational project proposals.

***Target Groups***

Potential beneficiaries registered and located in one of the Programme eligible regions, falling under one of the categories below:

- a. Local, regional and, if needed for the project purpose, national authorities;
- b. Bodies governed by public law, such as state/regional owned institutes, universities and educational institutions, tourism and regional development agencies, cultural and archaeological associations/institutions, nature park and protected areas management bodies, and research institutes;
- c. Non-profit organisations such as associations, unions, foundations, private universities if their legal status is of a non-profit organization, Euro regions, European Grouping of Territorial Cooperation.

***Event approach***

- Participants will be required to pre-register
- The event will be interactive, allowing time for Questions and Answers, and will have two parts: the first part will be theoretical providing information about the new Programme and the call for proposals and the second part will consist of a practical exercise with the purpose to identify transnational problems and opportunities to be addressed via the Programme;
- Evaluation forms will be distributed in the participant pack and collected at the end to get feed-back on the event and also to get information on what further support might be needed.
