







### **Title of the Programme**

The complete identifying title of the Programme, to be used in all communication activities, is "Interreg NEXT Black Sea Basin Programme".

### **Principles**

Efficient communication is the key to ensuring the transparency of the use of the EU funds, as well as the dissemination of project results.

Successful Programme communication relies on good project results to showcase how each project has an impact and improves the life of citizens in the Black Sea Basin. It also relies on a relevant community of projects that demonstrates the added value of transnational cooperation.

Project partners have to follow the visibility requirements for all co-financed visibility, transparency and communication activities. In this way, project partners properly acknowledge the support received from the Programme and communicate the role and achievements of Interreg. Visibility requirements apply to all co-financed printed and digital products, publications, websites (including their mobile views), online, offline and on-site activities and events, physical investments and purchase of equipment by the project partners.

## Compliance with Programme visibility rules will be checked throughout the project implementation.

Projects risk adverse financial consequences if disregarding the visibility requirements. If amendments to violated visibility requirements are not possible, the MA may **cancel up to 2% of the support** from the Programme co-financing. The financial cuts take into account the principle of proportionality.

# Transparency and communication legal requirements

According to *Article 36 of Regulation (EU) No. 2021/1059* **project partners** should acknowledge the support received from the Interreg NEXT Black Sea Basin Programme by:

- 1. providing on official partner's website. social or media sites, where such short sites exist. a of the description operation (project's aims and results, and the Programme financial support included);
- 2. providing a **statement** highlighting the the support from **Programme funds** in a visible manner on documents and communication materials relating to the implementation of the operation, intended for the general public or for participants;
- billboards\* clearly visible to the public, presenting the emblem of the Union in accordance with the technical characteristics laid down in Annex IX of Regulation (EU) 2021/1060, as soon as the physical implementation of an operation involving physical investment, or the purchase of equipment starts, or purchased equipment is installed, the total cost of which exceeds EUR 100.000;
  - 4. for operations not falling under point 3, publicly displaying at least one poster\* of a minimum size A3 or equivalent electronic display with information about the operation, highlighting the support from Programme funds.

### **Logo of the Programme - USE**

Apart form the Programme logo, no other visual identity or logo must be used to highlight the support from the EU

### General

The minimum visibility element that must be included in all communication materials is the **Standard logo** of the Interreg NEXT Black Sea Basin Programme. The standard logo is the full color version in the color codes specified on previous page.

Alternative logos are to be used whenever the use of the standard logo is not possible, for example, because the background or context infringes on its readability. The monochrome versions may only be used in justified cases.

As a justified exception, where the promotional items/ equipments are too small to include the standard logo of the Programme, the minimum visibility element to be included is the **EU emblem** and the words "**Co-funded by the European Union**". If the items/equipments are still too small, they will have to include at least the EU emblem.





### **Background color**

Ideally, the logo should be used on white, or light backgrounds only.

If the logo needs to be placed on a dark background, it must be in a white background rectangle box.

When using a white background box is not possible due to space restrictions, context, or because it would cover an important element of the background image, you may use a white & color version. In that case, the logotype, EU emblem border and statement must be in white using the following color codes:

Colour White Pantone/ CMYK 0/0/0/0 HEX fffff RGB 255/255/255

The size of the EU emblem border must be 1/25 of the height of the emblem.

### **Projects Names**

Project names/logos are not a part of the Programme logo, but rather should be considered as an annexed element. As such, the Programme logo should always appear any time the project name or logo is used.

Projects are free to develop their own logo. Alternatively, they should simply use their name written in **Montserrat Bold**, using the Reflex Blue color, or the color of their thematic objective (see next page).

The project name cannot exceed the width of an area equivalent to the width of the Interreg logotype and EU emblem combined and the height equivalent to the height of the EU emblem.



**Project name** 

The **standard placement** for project names/logos is below the Interreg NEXT logo, separated by a thin straight line. The project name/logo is positioned against the top left corner of the custom area.

Alternatively, project names/logos may be used in a **horizontal placement**, to the left or right side of the Programme logo, as long as the two are separated by a thin straight line.

Project names/logos shall never be positioned above the Programme logo.

are used either with a transparent, or a white background








# Monochrome icons: positive
