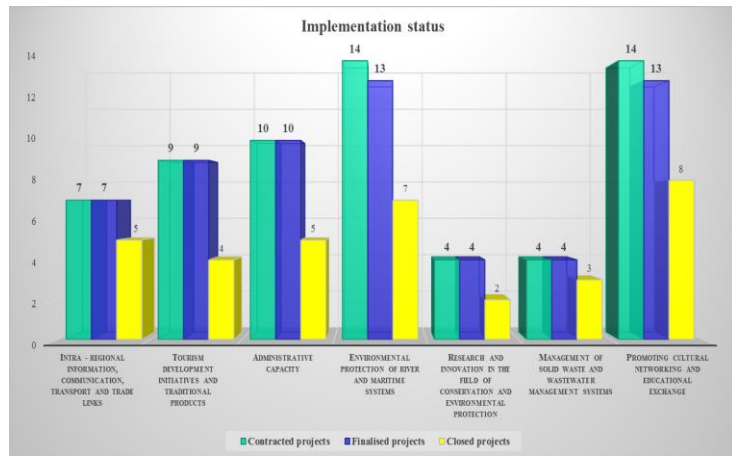


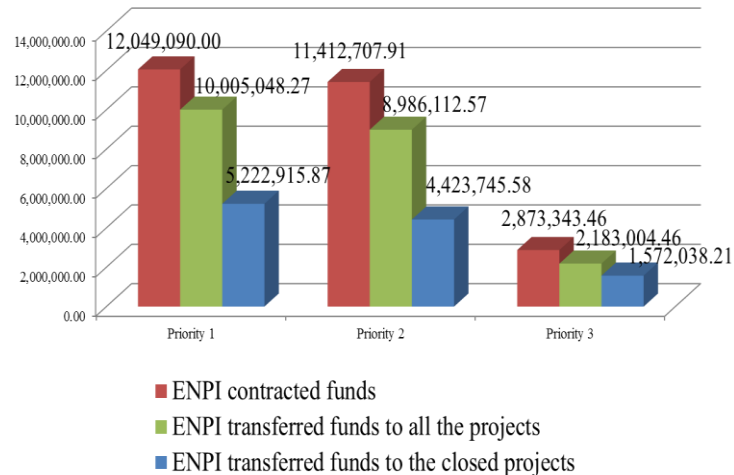

Status of projects implementation

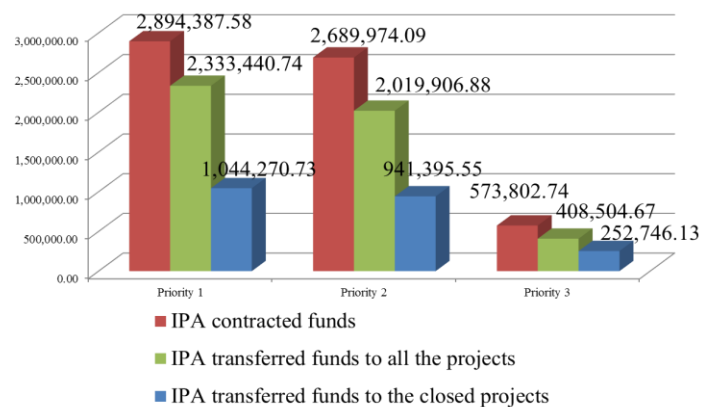


ENPI funds transferred to all the projects, per priority

The 11th Meeting of the Joint Monitoring Committee



The 11th meeting of the Joint Monitoring Committee (JMC) of the Black Sea Basin Joint Operational Programme 2007-2013 was held in Thessaloniki, Greece, on the 13th of October 2016.

The Joint Monitoring Committee discussed aspects related to the implementation of the projects awarded under the two calls of proposals, focusing on issues causing delays in the project closure phase, the results achieved so far by the projects, the status of the programme financial implementation and programme closure.

The ENPI CBC closing & ENI CBC launching conference

The ENPI CBC closing & ENI CBC launching conference, dedicated to celebration of cross-border cooperation along the EU’s external borders, was held in Brussels on the 15th -16th of November 2016.

The representatives of the European Commission, programme bodies and National Authorities of the member States and Partner Countries dialogued about the **benefits derived from cross-border cooperation** in the eligible areas, general statistics on the **achievement of the ENPI CBC Programmes** and **best practice examples** of funded projects, but also about what **opportunities ENI CBC offers** for the future, strategies and how they were selected, **fields of intervention** and how to ensure **complementarity with other initiatives** implemented in the eligible areas.
